RESOURCE CAREGIVER LICENSE RENEWAL/RE-CERTIFICATION CHECKLIST

The items listed below are required for <u>ALL</u> licensed resource caregivers (applicant and co-applicant). All licensing renewal requirements must be completed prior to 90-days from your license end date. Please use this checklist to keep track of all required documents that are required and you have submitted via your online licensing portal account.

- Providing false information is immediate grounds of revocation of your license.

- Resource Caregiver Annual Renewal Survey: complete the following survey to tell us about your experience over the <u>past 12-months</u> with Child Welfare Services. You will have an opportunity to provide feedback on the CWS Caseworker (the child's caseworker), CWS Licensing Worker (assigned to you) and other parts of the foster care system. Your feedback is valuable and will be used to make improvements and/or continue doing the positive things that you found helpful.
